#### Chapter Breakdown:

Paisley strives for self discovery inspired by 8 exciting Miss Lori songs and videos. Over the course of this musical adventure of discovery Paisley gains confidence in her ability to learn and ultimately completes her assignment with the help of her trusted mentor Miss Lori, and her new friends in the audience. "GROWING!" is targeted for children 2-8 years of age, (Preschool-2nd grade).

#### Cast:

The musical is performed by Miss Lori herself and a CAMPUS Kid who plays Paisley. The third member of the cast is the audience. They are an integral part of the story telling process.

#### Production Requirements:

The show requires a play space at least 10 x 10, in an environment that can easily accommodate children and their families. There needs to be a projection screen with a DVD player attached and dedicated stage lighting. Sound requirements are two headset mics, mixer and speaker system. The tour set includes a carpet, bench, side table, tree, easel and flower pot. The tour also travels with merchandise and front of house signage.
